This has assisted sheds in Lithgow; Hunters Hill/Ryde; Canada Bay; Swansea, and Peak Hill either getting started or filling gaps in their needs.

Kevin Callinan who is also Secretary of NSW Branch of AMSA has been able to arrange for "The Shed" to collect these items and store them at Warrawee.

The range of items varies from time to time and if your shed is in need of an item. Currently there is available large machinery and small power tools as well as hand tools
